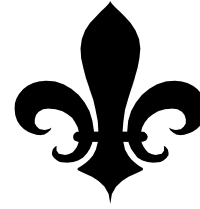

**Dinner Money – Spring Term 2012** - Dinner Money remains at £2.10 per day/£10.50 per week. For the first half of the Spring Term the cost will be £58.80 (cheques payable to Suffolk County Council).

**Full Time Admission to Primary School – Academic Year 2012-2013** – A reminder that if you have a child born between 1 September 2007 and 31 August 2008 you must make an application for a full time school place for your child by the closing date of Friday 13 January 2012. If you would like any help in completing the form, please speak to a member of the office staff or myself. Please note, that you still need to apply for a school place even if your child currently attends nursery.

**Thank you – thank you for all your parental support this term** and as I said before the Ofsted Inspectors commented on parents favourable views towards the school. Ofsted now has a new website <http://parentview.ofsted.uk>. "Parent View" gives you the chance to tell Ofsted what you think about your child's school. Parent View asks for your opinion on 12 aspects of your child's school, from the quality of teaching, to dealing with bullying and poor behaviour. Ofsted then use the information you provide when making decisions about which schools to inspect, and when.

By sharing your views, you'll be helping your child's school to improve. You will also be able to see what other parents have said about your child's school. Or, if you want to, view the results for any school in England. Please note that Parent View does not currently include independent schools.
